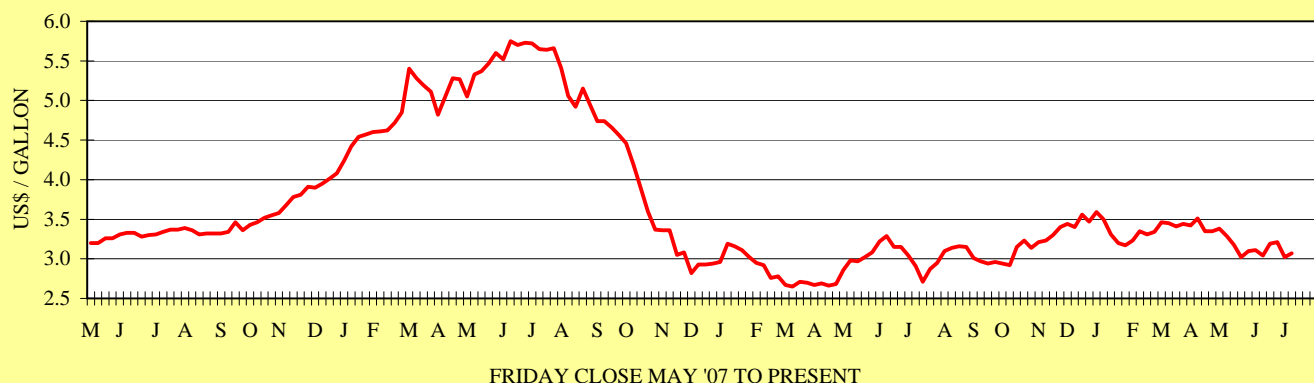

BITS AND PIECES - The US Senate failed to pass the tax extenders package, which included the extension of the \$1 per gallon credit for biodiesel producers. Sen. Charles Grassley continues to try to move this legislation ahead and it is likely that it will be included in an energy bill that will be put before the Senate later this month. ---- The state of Massachusetts has delayed implementing the mandate requiring a 2 pct biodiesel blend in petroleum products for one year, to July 1, 2011. ---- The US Energy Information Administration is projecting US ethanol production will grow from 700 thsnd barrels per day in 2010 to 850 thsnd per day in 2011.
